SCHEDULE	Use Schedule B to report tax due on telephone , telegraph , and nonresidential utility services in certain counties where school districts or cities impose tax, and on residential energy sources and services subject to local taxes.															
SCHEDULE FR	Use Schedule FR to report retail sales of motor fuel or diesel motor fuel , and fuel taken from inventory, as explained in the Schedule FR instructions.															
SCHEDULE	Use Schedule H to report sales of clothing and footwear that were eligible for exemption from New York State and some local sales and use tax.															
SCHEDULE	Use Schedule N to report taxes due and sales of certain services in New York City . Reminder: Providers of parking services must also file Schedule N-ATT (Form ST-810.5-ATT).
